Animal Farm Propaganda Poster Activity

Propaganda fulfils these qualities:

- It presents an issue in a very subjective and often misleading light, primarily meant to persuade rather than inform.
- It uses catchy slogans and images to attract the attention of the audience.
- It targets a specific audience with a specific purpose.

TASK:

Select an animal whose popularity needs a boost or select a "cause" (such as animalism).

You may also select a leader or a cause truly deserving of your support, or you may select one that is not to **create** a **propaganda poster** that **illustrates an issue** facing the animals. Examine WWI and WWII propaganda posters (especially from the Soviet Union) to get ideas. **Be prepared to present it to the class**. – Due Tuesday, October 11, 2016





Include the following within your poster:

- 1. **Poster**: Must be 12 x 18 (nothing larger or smaller, I will provide you with this).
- 2. **Propaganda**: Your poster should have a message and use one of the propaganda techniques discussed in class You can only use ONE! (Bandwagon, Testimonial, loaded word, misuse of statistics, name calling or stereotyping, plain folks, snob appeal, transfer)
- 3. **Color**. At least three. Look at the strong colours such as black, red and blue what do these colours portray? How can you use them to your advantage?
- 4. A slogan. Flashy words or title that attracts the viewer's attention and is tied to the issue from the novel.
- 5. **Paragraph(s)/Presentation**. Write *at least* a paragraph on the poster explaining what your poster is meant to represent and be ready to present it to the class. Make sure you answer these questions in your paragraph/speech:
 - What event or issue in the novel is this poster about? Be specific.
 - What propaganda technique does your poster use? Why is it effective?
 - Why is your slogan appropriate?
